

Frequently asked Questions

Q. What should I wear?

A. Dress is casual for the weekend. The Saturday night Banquet is a semi formal event calling for Sunday best.

Q. When does the first session start?

A. 7 pm

Q. What do the children do during sessions?

A. An optional Character Camp is offered as a safe place for children ages 5-11 while the parents are learning, free of charge. Parents are responsible for insuring that their children have sufficient supervision at all times. No child of any age is allowed to roam the grounds during parent sessions.

Q. How many meals are covered under the meal plan?

A. Five- Three on Saturday and two on Sunday. An optional hot dog dinner is available for those who rsvp before the camp.

Q. What time is registration?

A. 5-7pm

Q. What are the accommodations like?

A. They are private rooms with two double beds and a private bath. No linens are provided. Please bring your own sheets, towels, and pillow cases.

Q. What about large families?

A. The private rooms will easily accommodate an additional double blow up mattress and a portable crib. There are a limited number of dorms available for families of 8 or more children at no extra charge. If you feel your family needs larger accommodations please contact us.

Q. Is there a Sunday service?

A. Yes. Although the format varies somewhat, it usually incorporates a few hymns, testimonies and last words from Nancy and Colin.

Q. What about babies and toddlers?

A. We provide an adjoining room to the mother's session with toys, videos, and supervision. Mother's helpers are available for assistance during sessions and meal times.
